

Driving to the A-Zone Range from Bryan

Take Hwy 21 west. Slow down for the 60 mph zone at Cooks Point, go on through Caldwell, slow down for the 60 mph zone in Dime Box, and keep going west. The first landmark you'll see is the Lincoln city sign on your right.



Drive another 1.5 miles and you'll see the Walch Store at the intersection of FM 1624 and Hwy 21, also on your right.



Another 3 miles and you'll see the Elm Creek Café on your left.



Another mile and you'll see the intersection of FM 2440 and Hwy 21 on your left. Just past the intersection on the right is a rest area. When you pass the rest area, start slowing down because your turn is coming up.



Past the rest stop there's a 70 mph sign



And the Manheim "city" sign with the yellow "intersection" sign for CR 107. Slow down and get ready to turn right.



Here's the CR 107 sign and part of the old Wachsmann store on your right just before the turn.



Here's CR 107 and the Berger goat and Beefmaster cattle signs. Turn right.



Turn right on CR107 and go about 3 miles. Stay to the right when you reach the CR 106 / CR 107 fork in the road



After the fork in the road, stay on CR 107 and continue driving. You will pass several houses and farms, then CR 107 makes a right angle turn and the pavement changes.



Keep going on CR 107 another 0.2 mile, until it intersects CR 145.



Turn right on CR 145, which ends in a cul de sac.



You'll be at our gate. If it's closed, wait for us to come open it.



If the gate is open, drive on through. Watch out for dogs, cows, deer and other animals. Follow the road about 400 yards to the range. Park in the marked area by the cattle pen.
