The Austin Rifle Club is holding a basic **Firearm Cleaning Workshop** on Saturday, July 29, 2006.

Instructors Trenton G. Twining and Dana Rigg will discuss the basic points of cleaning a firearm, answer your questions, and explain the importance of routine cleaning. The class will compare basic cleaning techniques and address some other points of maintenance as allowed by class interest and time.

Equipment and Supplies:

Students may bring any one of the following firearms (or clones thereof): 1911-pattern pistol (AKA Colt .45 automatic); Beretta 92FS/M9; Browning/FN Hi-Power; Colt, S&W or Taurus double-action revolver; Colt SAA; CZ75B; Glock; Kahr; KelTec; NAA revolver; Remington 1875 revolver; Ruger std model pistol MkI or MkII; Walther PPK; Mauser-type bolt-action rifle. Any key/screwdriver/wrench as appropriate – e.g. a bushing wrench for a 1911; a small standard screwdriver for any of the DA revolvers listed, etc. Bring your owner’s manual if at all possible; many are available on the internet.

Students must also bring to class: clean, dry rags; (optional) cleaning mat (an oil & water resistant and slightly padded surface on which to work); cleaning kit (mops, rods, jags, brushes etc.); cleaning patches; detailing brushes (a clean tooth brush may serve).
